### Entry Guidelines

#### Swimmer Eligibility

1. Swimmers must have competed in two BCSL swimming dual meets during the 2021 season to be eligible to compete at championships.

#### Entries

1. A team may enter as many swimmers as they want into the meet. There are no cutoff times. A team may also enter as many swimmers as they want in each individual event. For relay events, however, a team may only enter one relay for each contested relay event.
2. A swimmer may be entered in a maximum of four events, including relays. Relay names should be submitted with a team's entries to ensure a swimmer is not entered into more than 4 events. Relay events – teams may only enter one relay per event.
3. Entries for championships must be on Hy-Tek Team manager software. They should be e-mailed to Sandy Payne at [sjpayne1@fuse.net](mailto:sjpayne1@fuse.net). Entries must be submitted to Sandy by **Sunday, July 18<sup>th</sup>** at 5pm. If a team submits their entries after the cutoff time, they will be fined \$100 by the league. Once Sandy received your entries, she will send an e-mail confirmation including a report of the team's entries. Coaches should review this report carefully to ensure the entries are accurate. Entry changes may be submitted up until noon on **Monday, July 19<sup>th</sup>**. Early in the afternoon on the 19<sup>th</sup> the psych sheet will be e-mailed to all head coaches and posted on the league website. At that time changes will no longer be permitted.
4. Entry times must be submitted to the nearest hundredth of a second. Entry times must have been achieved during the 2021 swim season. Verification of times must be presented upon request. An entry with a "NT" should be avoided if possible.
5. Entry fees: \$1.75 for each individual event and \$6.00 for each relay. Each team will also be charged an additional fee for each swimmer you enter into the meet. Sandy Payne will e-mail each team how much they owe with their entry report. Teams will be expected to bring their payment to Wednesday prelims and given to Katie Crank (NLH). Please make checks payable to BCSL.

## **Warm-ups**

Each team will be assigned a warm-up period during each warm-up session.

### Wednesday Prelims:

11&older swimmers warm-ups will begin at approximately 7:10am. The morning session will begin at approximately 8:40am.

10&under swimmers warm-ups will begin at approximately 1:00pm. The afternoon session will begin at approximately 2:30pm.

**These times are subject to change.**

### Thursday Finals:

All age groups will warm-up beginning 4:45pm. The Finals session will begin at approximately 6:15pm.

## **Awards**

Results for each age/gender's event will be posted shortly after each event. Finalists (places 1-12, alternates 13-14) will be announced during prelims. 30 Min. scratch rule will be in effect. Medals/Ribbons will be distributed to coaches at end of Finals. Plaques will be presented to teams following age-group awards. BCSL provides all awards (with the exception of Heat Winners).

### Individual Awards

Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Ribbons will be awarded for 4<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> place in each age group event.

Heat Winner prizes for the afternoon prelim session will be provided by Rolling Hills.

### Team Scoring

Individual Event Points:

Final Heat: 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9      Consolation Heat: 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Relay events scoring will be doubled the individual event points.

### Team Awards

Teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive a team plaque. High point age group winners will be awarded an age group plaque.

## **Clerk of Course**

Clerk of course will be located directly behind the blocks for **ALL** age groups in the afternoon session on Wednesday, July 21<sup>st</sup>.

## **Facilities**

### Parking

The lower parking lot will be restricted to officials, coaches, and handicapped, etc. There is parking in the upper lot, along Kingsbury Rd and the surrounding neighborhood roads. Swimmers can be dropped off at the entry gate. Please be respectful of where you are directed to park by our volunteers so we can maximize our parking space on our property.

### Team Areas

All team areas will be located in a designated area and marked with their team's name. All team members are expected to use trash cans and leave your area clean.

The Baby Pool and Diving Well will be CLOSED during the meet.

The bathrooms will be open for changing and handwashing. Urinals will be available in the men's restroom. There will also be porta potties (including handicap accessible) available.

### Seating

Bleacher seating will be available on the side of the pool. Advise your families to bring a lawn chair and tents if needed for use in the team area. We are asking that no one "set up camp" on the pool deck or in the bleachers. Space is limited and this will give all families an opportunity to see their swimmer race. We appreciate your help in this matter.

## **Concessions**

Concessions will be open throughout all sessions of the meet.

## **Hospitality**

Hospitality for Coaches and Officials will be located next to the shed in the parking lot during Prelims and Finals for snacking and drinks. Lunch will be provided to Coaches and Officials between the morning and afternoon Prelims session.

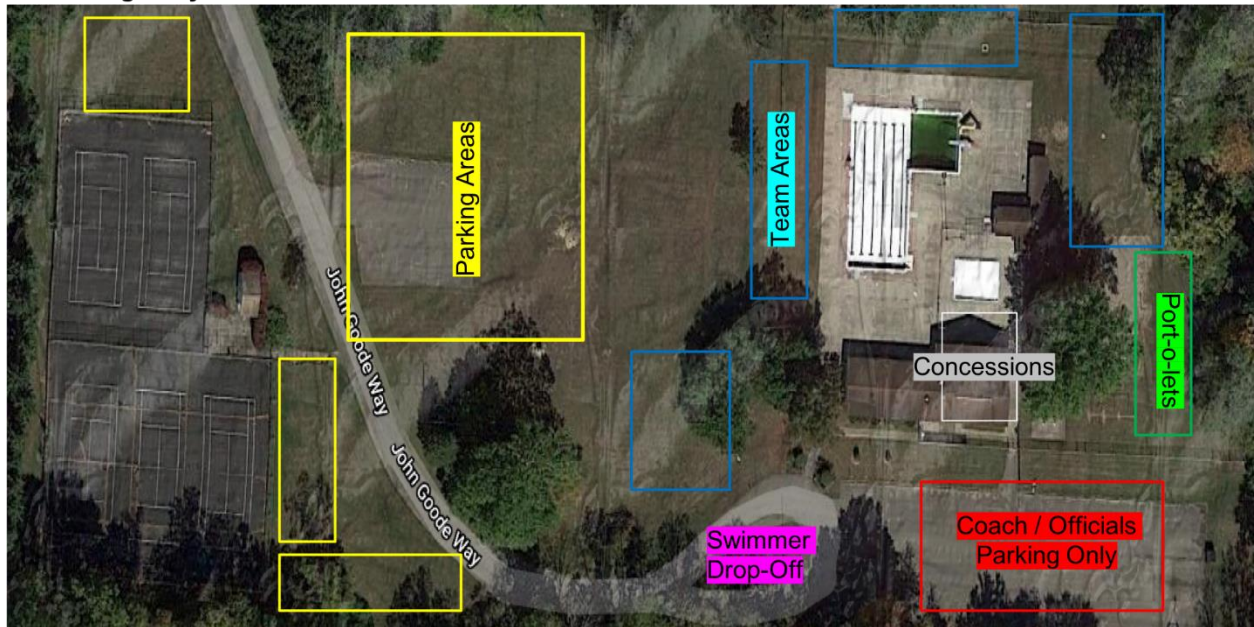
All workers should bring a refillable water bottle. Water stations will be available.

## **First Aid**

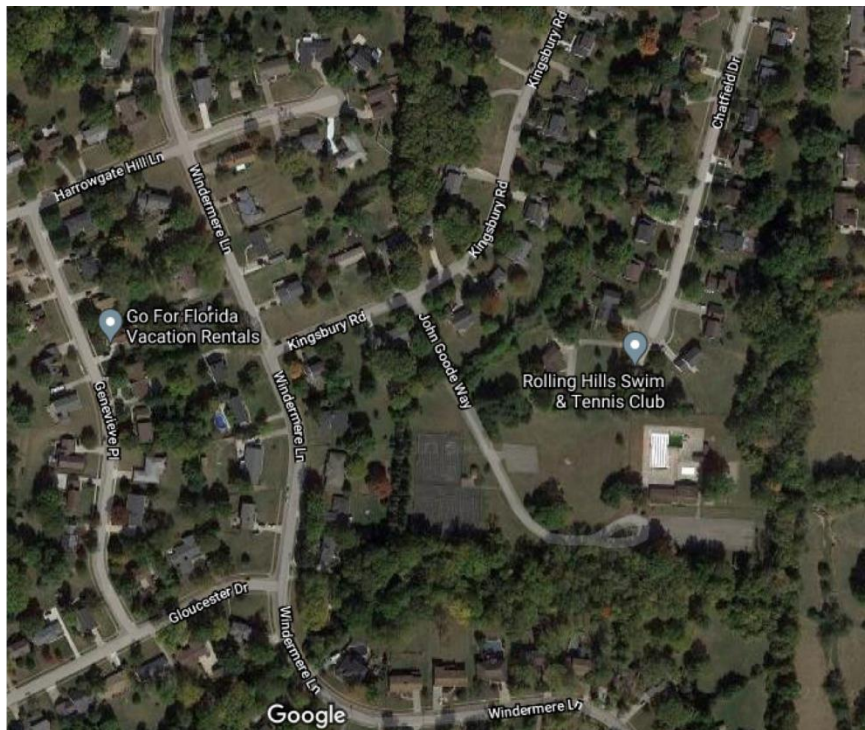
First Aid will be located in the guard office. See staff for assistance.
