## Entry Guidelines:

### Swimmer Eligibility

Swimmers must have competed in two BCSL swimming dual meets during the 2016 season in order to be eligible to compete at championships.

### Entries

1. A team may enter as many swimmers as they want into the meet. There are no cutoff times.  
A team may also enter as many swimmers as they want in each individual event. For relay events, however, a team may only enter one relay for each contested relay event.
2. A swimmer may be entered in a maximum of four events, including relays. Relay names should be submitted with a team's entries to ensure a swimmer is not entered into more than 4 events.
3. Entries for Championships must be on Hy-Tek Team Manager Software. They should be emailed to Sandy Payne at [sjpayne1@fuse.net](mailto:sjpayne1@fuse.net). Entries must be submitted to Sandy by Sunday, July 17<sup>th</sup> at 5 PM. If a team sends their entries in after this cutoff they will be fined \$100 by the league. Once Sandy receives your entries she will send an email confirmation including a report of the team's entries. Coaches should review this report carefully to ensure the entries are accurate. Changes may be made to this report up until noon on Monday, July 18<sup>th</sup>. Early in the afternoon on the 18<sup>th</sup> the psych sheet will be emailed to all head coaches and also posted on the league website. At that time changes will no longer be permitted.
4. Entry times must be submitted to the nearest hundredth of a second. Entry times must also have been achieved during the current swim season. Verification of times must be presented upon request. An entry with a "NT" should be avoided if at all possible.
5. Entry Fees: \$1.50 for each individual event and \$5.00 for each relay. Each team will also be charged an additional \$1.00 for each swimmer you enter into the meet. Sandy Payne will email each team how much they owe with their entry report. Teams will be expected to bring their payment to Wednesday prelims.

**Warm-ups:**

Each team will be assigned a warm-up period during each warm-up session.

Wednesday Prelims:

11 & Older swimmers warm-ups will begin at approx. 7:10 AM. The morning session will begin approx. 8:40AM

10 & Under swimmers warm-ups will begin at approx. 1:00. The afternoon session will begin approx. 2:30

Thursday Finals:

All age groups will warm-up beginning 4:30PM. The Finals session will begin approx. 6:00PM

**Awards**

Results for each age/gender's event will be posted shortly after each event.

Finalists (places 1-12, alternates 13-14) will be announced during prelims. 30 Min. scratch rule will be in effect. Medals/Ribbons will be distributed to coaches at end of Finals. Plaques will be presented to teams following age-group awards.

BCSL provides the following awards:

**Individual Awards**

Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 12th place in each age group event.

### Team Scoring

Individual event points:

Final Heat: 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9 Consolation Heat: 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.

Relay events scoring will be doubled the individual event points.

### Team Awards:

Teams finishing 1st, 2nd and third will receive a team plaque.

High point age group winners and runner-up winners will be awarded an age group plaque.

### Clerk Of Course:

Clerk of Course will be located under the main shelter for all age groups in the afternoon session on Wednesday, July 21<sup>st</sup>.

## Facilities

### Parking

The area in front of the Hy-crest pool will be available for parking. Coaches and officials will park to the right of the parking lot in a designated lot.

Officials and coaches will be provided with parking passes that should be displayed in their car. Parking attendants will be provided to direct traffic. A list of coaches and certified officials needs to be emailed to Carrie Gavigan at [cgavigan@cinci.rr.com](mailto:cgavigan@cinci.rr.com) no later than Wednesday July 13<sup>th</sup>.

The main lot will be used for Handicap parking.

### Team Areas

All team areas will be located in a designated area and marked with their team name. All team members are expected to use trash cans and leave your area clean. The Baby Pool will be CLOSED during the meet, it is being used as hospitality for the coaches and officials.

There will also be portalets available.

### Concessions

Concessions will be open throughout all sessions of the meet.

We have obtained a liquor license for the event, so beer will be sold. Alcohol cannot be brought into the event.

## **Seating**

Bleacher seating will be available on the side of pool. You can bring lawn chairs and tents for use in the team areas.

## **Hospitality**

Hospitality for coaches and officials will be located in the baby pool area during prelims and finals. Hy-crest will provide breakfast 7:00am on Wednesday, a meal from East of Chicago on Wednesday for lunch at 12:00 which will include salad, pizza, and garlic bread, etc. Dinner vouchers will be provided for dinner on Wednesday. Thursday, Chick fil A sandwiches will be provided for dinner. Various snacks and drinks will be provided for free throughout the meet both days. Bottled water will be available to timers. Please see hospitality for all drinks.
