Entry Guidelines

Swimmer Eligibility

1. Swimmers must have competed in two BCSL swimming dual meets during the 2023 season to be eligible to compete at championships.

Entries

- 1. A team may enter as many swimmers as they want into the meet. There are no cutoff times. A team may also enter as many swimmers as they want in each individual event. For relay events, however, a team may only enter one relay for each contested relay event.
- 2. A swimmer may be entered in a maximum of four events, including relays. Relay names must be submitted with a team's entries to ensure a swimmer is not entered into more than 4 events. Teams may only enter one relay per relay event.
- 3. Entries for championships must be on Hy-Tek Team manager software. They should be e-mailed to Sandy Payne at sipayne1@fuse.net. Entries must be submitted to Sandy by Sunday, July 23rd at 5pm. If a team submits their entries after the cutoff time, they will be fined \$100 by the league. Once Sandy receives your entries, she will send an e-mail confirmation including a report of the team's entries. Coaches should review this report carefully to ensure the entries are accurate. Entry changes may be submitted up until noon on Monday, July 24th. Early in the afternoon on the 24th the psych sheet will be e-mailed to all head coaches and posted on the league website. At that time changes will no longer be permitted.
- 4. Entry times must be submitted to the nearest hundredth of a second. Entry times must have been achieved during the 2023 swim season. Verification of times must be presented upon request. An entry with a "NT" should be avoided if possible.
- 5. Entry fees: \$2.00 for each individual event and \$8.00 for each relay. Each team will also be charged an additional \$2.00 surcharge for each swimmer you enter into the meet. Sandy Payne will email each team how much they owe with their entry report. Teams will be expected to bring their payment to Wednesday prelims and be given to Ahna Nichols (NLH). Please make checks payable to BCSL.

Warm-ups

Each team will be assigned a 20 minutes warm-up period during each warm-up session.

Wednesday Prelims:

- 11&older swimmers warm-ups will begin at 7:10am. The morning session will begin at 8:40am.
- 10&under swimmers warm-ups will being at 1:00pm. The afternoon session will begin at 2:30pm.

These times are subject to change.

Thursday Finals:

• All age groups will warm-up beginning 4:40pm. The Finals session will begin at 6:15pm.

Awards

Results for each age/gender's event will be posted shortly after each event. Finalists (places 1-12, and alternates 13-14) will be announced during prelims. 30 Min. scratch rule will be in effect. Medals/Ribbons will be distributed to coaches at end of Finals. BCSL provides all awards (with the exception of Heat Winners).

Individual Awards

Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 12th place in each age group event.

Team Scoring

Individual Event Points:

Final Heat: 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9 Consolation Heat: 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Relay event scoring is double the individual event points. (32, 26, 24, 22, 20, 18)

Team Awards

Teams finishing 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , and 3^{rd} will receive a team plaque.

Clerk of Course

Clerk of course will be located under the tent behind the dive well. This is for **ALL** age groups in the afternoon session on Wednesday, July 27th. There will be volunteers there to organize the U10 swimmers into their heats and will walk them to the blocks. We ask parents and coaches to release their swimmers to the volunteers and not enter the Clerk of Course area. All U10 swimmers MUST have their LAST NAME and AGE written on their back shoulder with a sharpie to help the volunteers guide them to their events.

Facilities

Parking

Each team will be provided <u>2 parking passes</u> for coaches each session. Please send the names of your 2 coaches for each session when you send the names of your timers. Names will be checked at the parking entrances. <u>There will be no paper passes issued</u>. If sending multiple coaches, carpooling is strongly suggested. Detailed parking information is provided at the end of the packet.

We are also offering a raffle all day Wednesday for VIP parking tickets during finals. Raffle will be 4 tickets for \$5. Winners will be drawn and announced at the end of the day (winners will be called/texted if not present).

Team Areas

All team areas will be located in a designated area and marked with their team's name. All team members are expected to use trash cans and leave your area clean. Team camp will be located in the grassy area behind the pool.

The Baby Pool and Diving Well will be CLOSED during the meet.

Bathrooms on deck will be closed except for changing only. There will be a male, female, and handicap Porta pots provided with a handwashing station. It is strongly suggested that parents accompany children to the area.

Seating

Advise your families to bring a lawn chair and tents for use in the team area. We are asking that no one "set up camp" on the pool deck or in the bleachers. Space is limited and this will give all families an opportunity to see their swimmer race. We appreciate your help in this matter.

Concessions

Concessions will be open throughout all sessions of the meet (Cash/Credit Cards accepted). A menu of available options is located at the end of this packet. Alcoholic beverages for those over 21 will be available at the pool and the gazebo. Coolers and outside food WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.

Hospitality

Hospitality for Coaches and Officials will be located in Vue 791. Breakfast and lunch will be available on Wednesday and dinner on Thursday for coaches and officials in time to partake prior to the start of the evening session. Bottled water will be provided.



ENTRANCE #2

Walk-in entrance to Forest Hills 2nd Ave Entrance. Use caution when turning left into parking lot. Space for **68** cars. Do not park in reserved spots for school workers.
